


Safety First

- Sheets, pillow, and blanket (or a sleeping bag)
(Cot and mattress are provided)
- Comfortable clothes for 2 days and an extra set just in case.
This includes underclothes, pants, shirts, and socks.
- Shoes (closed toed like sneakers)
- Light Jacket, sweater, or a sweatshirt
- Towel and wash cloth
- Bathroom stuff (like a toothbrush and toothpaste)
- Flashlight (if desired)

WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

The duties of the adults in camp depend on the activity.

1. Help supervise the boys while you are in camp.
2. Horseshoe/Washers
This may include watching the boys and attempt to keep limit the horseplay, keeping score, and keeping the boys safely out of harm's way.

NOTE: You do not have to know the rules there are leaders present who can assist in this area.

3. Fishing
This may include keeping the boys safe from wild hooks, bait hooks, taking pictures of caught fish, and releasing the fish back into the lake.

NOTE: You do not have to know the how to fish, there are leaders present who can assist in this area.

4. Nature Walk, Canoeing, or Wide Game
Camp Allen staff will oversee these activities. Brothers Andrew are there to provide support and help keep horseplay down so boys do not get hurt.

5. Meals
Brothers may be asked to help serve, get trays and silverware to the dishwashing area, and help clean up.
