WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

The duties of adults in the camp depend upon the activity.

1. Help supervise the boys while you are in camp.
2. **Horseshoes/Washers:** This may include watching the boys, limiting horseplay, keeping score, and keeping the boys safely out of harms way.
NOTE: You do not have to know the rules; there are leaders present who can assist in this area.
3. **Fishing:** This includes keeping the boys safe from wild hooks, bait hooks, taking pictures of caught fish, and releasing fish back into the lake.
NOTE: You do not have to know how to fish; there are leaders present who can assist in this area.
4. **Nature Walk, Canoeing, or Wild Game:** Camp Allen staff will oversee these activities. Brothers Andrew are there to provide support and help keep horseplay down so boys do not get hurt.
5. **Meals:** Brothers may be asked to help serve, get trays and silverware to the dishwashing area, and help clean up.
